Attendance/Term Time Holidays

As you know good attendance is very important in school. There is a strong correlation between attendance and making good progress in school, this was evident in the end of year assessments nearly one quarter of our school children had an end of year attendance lower than 95%, which is considered poor. Term Time holidays have become a concern for the school: our Attendance Policy states that term time holidays will be considered by our Governing Body and now states that any term time holidays over 10 days will be referred to the Local Authority. Good Attendance is positively promoted within school: not only is it important for learning but helps to foster good working ethics for the future. Please ensure that you encourage good attendance with your child/ren. If your child cannot attend school, it is extremely important that you contact the school office by 9.30am. The preferred method is via the Parentmail App.

Open Afternoon
