

Dear Parents/Carers,

Reminder - Attendance/ Term Time holidays

We are currently experiencing a large number of children missing school from term time holidays. Please note that time away from school does require an application via a holiday form from the school office.

Over the course of this year, we have observed children finding it difficult to settle back into a school routine after a holiday (sleeping, friendships, catching up with work). Parents/children are encouraged to take work away with them but this does not substitute the quality first teaching they experience from their teachers and the teaching environment.

During the Autumn term, 60% of our children had at least one absence and in the Spring term this figure rose to 68% (these figures include holidays and illnesses). These figures indicate how difficult it is for teachers to teach their classes when children have 'odd days off' or blocks of time off school.

I firmly believe that there is a strong link to school progress and attendance and I hope you will support us with this. I have provided quick links to the term time dates.
